Water Meter Replacement Project

- In collaboration with Baystate Winsupply and Weston and Sampson, we are continuing to upgrade the City's water metering system. MWRA - Water Main Improvements & Rehabilitation Project

- Albanese D&S, Inc. to continue MWRA watermain installation on Common Street between Belmont Street and Bellevue Road. Please visit the MWRA link for more information and updates.

Eversource - Waltham, Watertown to Brighton Reliability Project

- Eversource crews from McCourt Construction will begin removing an existing buried splice underground in Watertown at the **intersection of Irving Street and North Beacon Street**. This work is associated with the Eversource Waltham, Watertown to Brighton Reliability Project (“Project”). This work is expected to last **five to six weeks** with crews excavating the roadway, removing existing infrastructure underground and temporarily restoring the road. **Please be assured that this work will not interrupt your electrical service.**

Crews will be working from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday to Friday**. Some work may be conducted beyond normal work hours or on Saturdays based on approval from city officials. Crews will coordinate closely with the Police Department to maintain a safe and effective flow of traffic around the project work areas.
